

## *Western National Standard of Excellence*

### *Show Results*

The State Fair of Oklahoma was the site of the IBBA Western National Standard of Excellence on September 22nd. The Western National Standard of Excellence is the second of the four national point shows of the 2012-2013 Show Year. Mr. Brandon Callis of Blinn College in Brenham, Texas evaluated cattle presented by breeders from Texas, Louisiana, Tennessee, Arkansas and Oklahoma.

In the competitive Red Brangus heifer show the champions included Grand Champion out of the Senior Heifer division, KK Miss Sidda Lee 317X4, exhibited by Katy Knox of Hempstead, Texas. Bailye Foltyn of Bay City, Texas, exhibited the Reserve Grand Champion Miss -C- Dutchess 30 Y, who came out of the Junior Heifer division.

the Show Sire and Dam, Show Bulls and Show Heifers of the Year in for both Red and Black Brangus. Show Animal Standings are posted by show on the IBBA website.

The next National Standard of Excellence Show will be the National Show of Merit on November 3, 2012. It will be hosted by the State Fair of Louisiana in Shreveport, Louisiana.
